OUR ROOMS

1: The Leaf Umbrella Room

Walk into this room and fall in love with the **queen canopy bed** and the view through the window into the courtyard with its English Cottage garden and bubbling fountain. The green color of the wall echoes an original watercolor of prickly pear cactus, stenciling, and a display of cranberry and cased blue leaf umbrella pattern glass. Feeling Romantic? Cozy up to the corner **fireplace**.

2: The Sugar Room

It's difficult to choose between luxuriating in the **king size bed**, curling up in one of the oversized wicker chairs in front of the **fireplace** or sitting just **outside the French doors** at a table and chairs surrounded by lush greenery and blooming flowers. On display is a wonderful collection of pattern glass made in the 19th century to hold the coarsely ground sugar available in that era. This room accommodates the physically challenged.

3: The Cut Glass Suite

What more can be said about sunning on your own **private patio**, two Adirondack chairs, and soaking in the bubbles of your own full size **hot tub**. Did we mention the sitting room and **fireplace** with views of the patio? This serene room with a California **king bed** can also be made into twins. A collection of contemporary black and white photographs adorns the muted walls. The innkeeper's collection of antique English and Irish cut glass jars give this room its name.

4: The Tiffany Room

The original bedroom of this residence now made into its most romantic room with a breathtaking **queen canopied queen bed** draped in filmy clouds of fabric, and a **wood-burning fireplace**. Spend some time snuggling on the love seat, reading in relaxing wicker chairs or on your **own deck** with two chaises and a table where you can linger. Part of the innkeeper's collection of Tiffany silver compliments the luxury of this room.

5: The Ivory Room

The **king bed** of this room, which can also be made into twins, looks out a window to the lush hillsides framing a view of the redwoods at the end of the valley. Enhanced by the **fireplace** and the overstuffed lounge chairs, this room with a display of ivory netsuke carvings is the place for long afternoon naps and a good book.

6: The Sandwich Glass Suite

The warmth of this suite overlooking the courtyard comes not only from the bold red walls, but also from the glow you'll feel as you curl up in super-cozy chairs in front of the **fireplace**, as you emerge from the **spa tub** for two, or reluctantly rise from the **queen bed**. A collection of sandwich glass tiebacks adds drama to this setting.

7: The Quilt Room

Whimsy abounds in every corner of this **queen bedroom** with a **spa** for two and comfy chairs from which to gaze into the **fireplace**. People lamps, a dramatic quilt, a five-foot pair of scissors and other accessories make this room one you'll long talk about.

8: The Marbles Suite

9: The Wine Country Room

10: The Kitchen Cupboard Room

Well, here you have all those memories surrounding a suite of antique walnut furniture, **queen bed**, a **fireplace**, two overstuffed chairs, the **spa tub**, and the **deck**. 11: The Heritage Room
